

**TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT REQUIRED OF/ RECOMMENDED TO M.F.A.
AND SPECIAL STUDENTS IN THE TECHNICAL DESIGN AND
PRODUCTION DEPARTMENT 2012-2013**

Note: Technical Interns should consult with advisors before purchasing tools and equipment.

Steel tape measure, 25' or longer	Nut drivers: 3/8" and 7/16"
Speed Square or combination square	Utility knife
Cordless screwgun/drill with charger and spare battery.	Socket wrench (3/8" drive) with 7/16", 1/2" and 9/16" deep-well sockets
Multi-Tool (Gerber Multi-Plier or Leatherman)	Center punch
Hammer	Toolbox or canvas tote
Screwdrivers: #2 Phillips, #2 and #3 flat	Mini-Mag or equivalent AA flashlight
Metal scribe	Architect's scale rule
8" adjustable wrench	Scientific calculator

We recommend that you mark your tools in a distinctive manner. Most solid colors are already used to mark YSD/YRT tool inventories, but initials, stripes, or other patterns will help distinguish your tools from everyone else's. We also recommend talking to 2nd and 3rd-year students and working in our shops before purchasing additional tools.
